Sci-Fi Feminist Connects with Readers thru Futurist Format

Sue Lange again engages the mind as she entertains the senses thru "Uncategorized," a collection of randomly genius short stories.

(National)—Re-defining the aspect of "Theater of the Mind," progressive sci-fi author Sue Lange takes advantage of new multi-media tools that technology affords the modern reader. In *Uncategorized* (BookViewCafe.com; 2009), her latest book, the short story meets old-time radio buckled up in a time machine and blasted into the future.

In this thought-provoking collection, Lange grabs the reader with an "audio download" and segues into her eclectic set of short stories with the aggressive delivery of a beat poet and the timing of a stand-up comedian. Her *Uncategorized* readers are certain to be a good crowd, for they will find themselves laughing out loud and at the same time nodding in agreement.

Lange's vast resume may explain her literal skills. "*Sue has worked for a living,*" as her bio puts it. Her work experience ranges from potato picker to first chair flautist *and* last chair flautist, drama club treasurer, to disco dance instructor, chemistry technician, right fielder *and* first base, plant laboratory supervisor (non-radiological), stage manager, actor, typesetter, songwriter, viticulturist, Digital Production Manager. And so much more.

Great experience provides great insight.

This may be why *Uncategorized* not only stimulates the senses, but provides a great deal of food for thought consumption. Just take a bite from the piece, "*MeatEaters,*" then jump to "*Suicides,*" and land somewhere with "*The Timestoppers.*" (All puns intended.)

Each story will provide a trigger for reflection and insight into one's own opinions and assumptions. And the sci-fi aspect provides an alternate worldview of real-world issues that will provide book clubs with hours of group, *and post-group* discussions.
